POOL SPECIAL EVENTS

- All pool parties must be booked 2 weeks prior to the event. When booking the party,
 the time and approximate number of people needs to be identified. Where the party
 will be located around the pool area will be discussed. Usually, if there is any food
 involved it will be set around the deck area in front of the snack bar or the circular stage
 area of the pool.
- 2. Any type of party up to 50 people is a \$100.00 set-up fee. Any party above 50 people and below 150 people the set-up fee will be \$200.00. The set-up fees include the set-up and breakdown of tables, food, and bar along with complete clean-up. These fees strictly apply around the pool area. In addition to set-up fee, there will be a per person fee that applies from the banquet menu along with 7% tax and 15% gratuity.
- 3. If it is a birthday party, a birthday cake can be brought in along with personalized birthday cups and plates.
- 4. The club must supply all other food and beverage.
- 5. Birthday parties cannot be held on any summer holidays such as Memorial Day, July 4th, or Labor Day.
- 6. All swim related parties require a lifeguard per 50 people. Lifeguards hourly rate is \$20.00 per hour, which will be billed to the host or sponsor and the club will reimburse the lifeguard in their paycheck that week.
- 7. All parties will go through our catering department, approved by our clubhouse manager and put on a function sheet to be approved and signed by the sponsor.
- 8. In case of bad weather, the club is flexible to move the date to another date or if there is an indoor area available the club will move the party inside.
- 9. If it is an evening banquet that will involve liquor being served per 50 people, the club requires that there be a security guard. The cost is \$15.00 per hour, which the sponsor will be responsible for.
- 10. After pool hours dinner/drink/dance parties can last until 1:00AM by the pool.
- 11. It is the host's responsibility to remove all decorations when they leave. We are not responsible for any items left by the pool.
